Bank & Investment Account#'s

Birth Certificates, Marriage Certificates, Graduation & Religious Documents

Copies of driver's licenses, Original Passports, Concealed Weapons Permits, Social Security Cards & Medicare/Medicaid Cards

Medical & Dental Information, Insurance Information, Insurance Cards

Accounts/Website Access Codes

Cash (small bills)

Titles to cars, boats, real estate deeds

Will/family trusts

Be sure and secure all of these documents and information in a secure/safe location ready to grab and go out the door.
