Before your Christmas tree becomes an issue follow these important tips:

Place your tree far away from sources of heat and exits locations.

Be sure to use only those decorations that are rated fire resistant.

Inspect your lights for any worn wires or other defects prior to using them.

Always keep an eye on your tree lights and be sure to turn them off at night.

Keep natural tree stands filled with water at all times and never let the tree dry out.

In the event that the tree becomes dry you should promptly remove it.
